



The Interallied Confederation of Medical Reserve Officers (CIOMR) is a transversal organization, in which the national existing associations of reserve medical surgeons of the NATO member states are unified.

As a politically independent and separate organization, the CIOMR makes a significant contribution to the force of the Alliance and to the latter development of military medicine, pharmacy and security policy in their homelands with the aid of further and professional training activities.

The Confederation's objectives are:

- To establish close relationships with medical reserve personnel and services within the Alliance.
- To study and to discuss subjects that are of military medical importance.
- To promote effective cooperation with the medical services of the Regular Forces by providing information and feedback throughout.
- To participate as an actively involved observer in the meetings and the Working Groups on Medical Training of COMEDS, the NATO Committee of Chiefs of Medical Services, and to bring its civilian medical expertise.
