



## Privacy and Cookies Policy

*Last Update: February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2016*

### 1.- Data Protection

In accordance with articles 5, 6 y 7 of the Ley Orgánica 15/1999, December 13th, de Protección de Datos de Carácter Personal (from now on LOPD) and the Real Decreto 1720/2007, 21st December, that approved its Regulation, I expressly agree that my personal data will be suitably processed by **Federación de Organizaciones De Reservistas de España** (from now on **FORE**) and **Hotel Meliá Castilla** as data controllers, for the purpose of the inscription and attendance to **CIOR-CIOMR SUMMER CONGRESS MADRID 2-6 AUGUST 2016**, as well as being offered some additional tourist services.

### 2.- Cookies

**FORE** uses cookies to improve browsing, provide you the service and to get statistics about how the website is used.

#### What is a cookie?

A cookie is a text file that is sent to the web browser on your computer, mobile or tablet and used to store and retrieve information about your browsing habits. For example, as a way to remember your username and password or the language in which you want to check the website.

#### What type of cookies are there?

According to the sender



- First party cookies: These ones are sent to your browser from our computers or web domain.
- Third party cookies: These ones are sent to your browser from a computer or web domain that we do not manage directly, but from a collaborating third party as for example Google.

According to its lifetime

- Session Cookies: These ones just remain on your device until you leave the website.
- Persistent Cookies: These ones remain on your device for a certain period of time, so every time you visit our website your browser can access them. These cookies stop working past a certain date.

According to its purpose

- Technical Cookies: These ones improve the browsing and the performance of the site.
- Personalized Cookies: These ones allow us to remember your personalized choices every time you visit the site.
- Analytic Cookies: These ones can measure and statistically analyze the use of the website.
